How will progress2work work for me?

The **progress2work** provider will put you in touch with one of their specialist caseworkers.

The caseworker will help you to look for and apply for jobs, or find the training you need to build up your skills and confidence so that you can go back to work.

If you are having problems with housing, or you have money worries, they can show you how to get help with those too.

When you are back in work or training, your caseworker will stay in touch with you for 13 weeks. They will support and help you with any problems that you may have during that time.
